

/!\ Safety Information

Important-Please read the instruction before assembly and keep it for further reference

•WARNING: Adult assembly required.

•WARNING: Be aware of the risk of open fire and other sources of strong heat, such as electric bar fires, gas fires etc in the near vicinity of the cot.

• **WARNING**: Do not use the cot if any part is broken, torn or missing and use spare parts approved by the manufacturer.

•WARNING: Do not leave anything in the cot, such as toys, or place the cot close to another product, which could provide a foothold or present a danger of suffocation or strangulation, e. g strings, blind/curtain cords etc.

•WARNING: Do not use your travel cot without the mattress.

•WARNING: Do not use more than one mattress in the cot.

WARNING: Keep your travel cot away from trailing cords or flexes.
 WARNING: Failure to extend the top rails and lock them securely

creates a safety risk. Always check that the rails are fully engaged before use.

•WARNING: To prevent the injury from falls, when the child can stand unaided or is able to climb out of the cot, the cot shall no longer be used for that child.

•WARNING: Do not use any other mattress which are not approved by the manufacturer.

•WARNING: Do not allow young children to play in the vicinity of the travel cot without supervision.

•WARNING: Do not use the bassinet when the child can sit or kneel or pull itself up.

•WARNING: Keep small parts out of the reach of children under 36 months because of possible choking hazard.

•WARNING: Ensure that the cot is fully erected and all the locking mechanisms engaged before placing your child in this cot.

• **WARNING**: Never leave your child unattended in the changing station. WARNING: All assembly fittings should always be tightened properly and that fittings should be checked regularly and

retightened as necessary.

• WARNING: The height of the cot base is adjustable, the lowest position is the safest and the that base should always be used in that position as soon as the baby is old enough to sit up.


•WARNING: The support rails are provided to support the cot base above its lowest position, the rail must be removed

before the cot is used in its lowest position.

WARNING: Warning-Only use the mattress sold with this cot, do not add a second mattress on this one, suffocation hazards.



2. Opening for use


Step1

Unzip the travel bag and remove the frame and mattress. Place the bassinet in the vertical position and open the touch fasteners to remove the mattress.




Step2

With the feet on the floor pull the feet apart so that they are approximately 60cm/24" apart. Lift the short sides of the bassinet upwards until they lock into position.




Step3

Now lift the long sides of the bassinet upwards until they lock into position. Check that all four sides have engaged correctly by pressing down on each arm at the centres. If you have difficulty locking the sides, lift the centre of the base a little higher and start the process again.




Step4

Now push the centre of the bassinet base downwards until it audibly locks into place.



Step5

Place the mattress in the travel bassinet with the padded side up.
Align the touch fasteners on the mattress with those on the base and press down to ensure they are stuck together.




3. Folding


Step1


Lift the handle in the base under the mattress pull the centre of the base upwards.


Step2

Lift the side rails slightly(a) and hold the lock in the middle of the rail (b) (indicated with arrows). Hold the lock pressed whilst gently lowering the side rail(c). Ensure that the side rail disengages on both sides of the mechanism. Pull together the 2 supporting legs underneath the fabric to center base as close as possible (d).










Step3

Repeat this process with the short sides. Check that all 4 sides have disengaged properly and then pull the centre of the base. If you have difficulty unlocking the sides, lift the centre of the base a little higher and start the process again.





Step4

With the upper part of the travel bassinet in the closed postion push all 4 feet together.



- a) Wrap the mattress around the travel bassinet tightly with the padded section inside. Fasten the touch fasteners through the tabs and secure. Pull the travel bag over the travel cot and close the bag with the zip. (shown in fig a)
- b) You may also pack all the additional parts listed in fig.b inside the whole packing at your own options.






Bassinet Assembly Instruction

Step 1

Remove the mattress pad from the bottom of the playard to use inside your bassinet.

Release VELCRO ® straps that hold down the mattress pad and remove from playard.




Step 2

Drape bassinet over the end of the ofbassinet.

Fasten the plastic clips on the top rail. There are 2 plastic clips on on each longer rail and 2 on each short rail.

IMPORTANT: You may adjust the position of the plastic clips on the rail, to make the bassinet in good shape after assembly.




Step 3

Take out 4 bassinet support tubes contained in PE bag.

Insert the bassinet tubes into the four bassinet sleeves. Ensure that one tapered tube is placed on each side and that tapered ends point inwards.

Connect the support tubes together.

Place the mattress onto the Bassinet




Convert into the co-sleeping position from the freestanding bassinet

Step 1

Remove the velcro from the inside of the lowering rail as picture.

Find the locking buckle under the plastic corners on left and right side, latch them outward to unlock and then slide down the top bar until it reach to the bottom limit.

Note: The left and right side plastic corner pieces must be slid down at the same time, so that the top rail can be lowered smoothly.



Step 2


Undo the zipper located on each short side, hide the fabric under the mattress, find the plastic hooks underneath the bassinet, then clip them onto the top bar firmly.

Place the mattress onto the bassinet

Warning: If a gap is visible on either side of the mattress after installing, reposition the mattress or bassinet then stretch the mattress and sheet on both ends to cover the gaps.



How to attach the Co-Sleeper bedside bassinet to adult bed



The top edge of the LOWERING RAIL when used in co-sleeping position must be level with or below the top of adult mattress.

Slide the anchor plate and straps under the mattress, placing the anchor plate flush against the mattress on the opposite side from this product.

Connect both straps to each short side of the bassinet by passing the male buckle through the "belt loop" at the front leg of the product and then connect the buckle to rear leg.

Make both straps as tight as possible against the parental bed, so tight it creates a slight indentation in mattress. To test if the product is tightly secured to adult bed, push it with hands to make sure the gap is no more than $\frac{1}{2}$ " (13mm). If more than $\frac{1}{2}$ " (13mm), readjust strap to pull tighter.


When bassinet is tight and ready to use, roll the excess strap up and secure.

Always tighten straps before each use.

It is recommended to make the strap shorter than the width of the mattress to ensure the Co-Sleeper is pressed securely against the parental bed, without any gaps.

WARNING: NEVER USE the product in bedside bassinet mode without the anchor plate and strap (L) attached to the adult bed. Failure to use this anchor plate and strap could result in serious injury or death to the infant. Make sure all anchor straps are secured and tight. Check straps before each use.

WARNING: Failure to use this securing system will allow the product to move away from the adult bed and could result in infant falling out of the product. NEVER leave infant unattended in this product.

MARNING: STRANGULATION/ CHOKING HAZARD

DO not allow excess strap (or any other loose object) to find it's way into this product. Do Not allow excess strap to lay loose on floor because someone may trip over it.

Care and Maintenance

Your child's safety is your responsibility

To clean the mattress base and travel cot fabric wipe it using a mild detergent and water. Never clean with abrasive, ammonia based, bleach based or spirit type cleaners. The travel cot must be dried thoroughly before use or storage.
